## MOTION TO CLARIFY SCHEDULING ORDER AND NOTICE OF HEARING REGARDING ISSUE OF JURISDICTION

Now comes the Bureau of Securities Regulation and requests the Hearing Officer clarify one minor aspect of the scheduling order issued on March 11, 2014.

In paragraph "D." the Scheduling Order provides: "On or before April 4, 2014 the respondents shall file a summary of relevant facts upon which the respondents shall rely in their argument at <u>hearing on the issue of jurisdiction.</u>" (Emphasis supplied.)

The Bureau believes that the summary of relevant facts to be filed on April 4, 2014 by the respondents concerns the hearing on the merits or the summary judgment motion that the Bureau will file if the Hearing Officer finds that he has jurisdiction in this matter. The parties agreed that the jurisdictional challenge shall be based on the facts alleged in the Motion to Enforce filed in this matter.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau requests the Hearing Officer modify paragraph "D" to read as follows:

D. On or before April 4, 2014, the respondents shall file a summary of relevant facts upon which the respondents shall rely in the event the hearing officer finds he has jurisdiction in this matter and the matter proceeds to a merits hearing or a summary judgment proceeding.
