REQUESTED ACTION

1. Pursuant to Chapter 195, Laws of 2013, subparagraph XIII, G, and in accordance with RSA 4:8-a, authorize the Department of Resources and Economic Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, Bureau of Historic Sites to accept the following monetary and in-kind donations totaling \$12,631.50 for the purpose of constructing the memorial commemorating the 400th anniversary of the discovery of the Isles of Shoals by John Smith at Ragged Neck in Rye Harbor State Park. A previous donation request was approved by Governor and Executive Council on July 16, 2014, Item #52.

2. Further authorize the Department to amend a **SOLE SOURCE** payment to Swenson Granite Works (VC #216482), Concord, NH by increasing the amount by \$618.69 from \$24,710.50 to \$25,329.19 for the cost to manufacture two (2) additional granite benches for the Smith Memorial at Ragged Neck upon Governor and Executive Council approval. The original payment amount was approved by Governor and Executive Council on July 16, 2014, Item #52. 100% Capital Fund (Match of State/Private Local Funds)

EXPLANATION

The Smith Memorial at Ragged Neck State Park will be a long lasting reminder of New Hampshire's early settlement and will encourage citizens and visitors alike to learn more about New England's rich history.




In 2013, a Capital Appropriation was approved for “a state match against private funds raised, up to \$40,000, for the purpose of constructing the memorial commemorating the 400th anniversary, of the discovery of the Isles of Shoals by John Smith at Ragged Neck in Rye Harbor State Park.” The Legislative Commission established, pursuant to Chapter 192:45, Laws of 2013, to construct the memorial sought and received both monetary and in-kind donations totaling \$53,830. All costs/expenditures associated with the installation and celebration of the monument total \$73,351. Therefore, only \$19,521 of the \$40,000 capital appropriation will be bonded resulting in an overall savings of \$20,479. A copy of the Department’s financial analysis is included for your review.


The Commission had originally identified Swenson Granite Works as the vendor of choice for the manufacture of the monument as they offered a 50% in-kind donation towards the cost. Approval to accept this donation and to make payment for the balance was approved by Governor and Executive Council on July 16, 2014, Item #52. The Commission later received 2 additional cash donations for 2 more benches to be incorporated into the monument design. Swenson’s performed this additional work and again offered a 50% in-kind donation towards the cost. For this reason, the Department is now seeking **sole source** approval to make an increased payment to Swenson’s.


The Smith Memorial at Ragged Neck State Park will be a long lasting reminder of New Hampshire's early settlement and will encourage citizens and visitors alike to learn more about New England's rich history.

In 2013, a Capital Appropriation was approved for “a state match against private funds raised, up to \$40,000, for the purpose of constructing the memorial commemorating the 400th anniversary, of the discovery of the Isles of Shoals by John Smith at Ragged Neck in Rye Harbor State Park.” The Legislative Commission established pursuant to Chapter 192:45, Laws of 2013, to construct the memorial has sought both financial and in-kind donations which amount to \$41,198.50 to-date. The total cost of the project including donations and payments to vendors is \$68,904.

The Commission identified Swenson Granite Works as the vendor of choice as they offered a 50% donation towards the cost of the monument (as presented in Section 1 of the Requested Action). Further, Saymore Trophy Company was selected by the Commission as the best candidate to provide etching of the bronze map plaque. For these reasons, the Department is seeking sole source approval to make payment to these vendors.
