REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department to accept a donation pursuant to RSA 4:8 of various firearm equipment from Mr. George Wells valued at approximately \$27,312.00. This equipment, if approved, would be provided to the Law Enforcement Division to be utilized for upgrades for the State issued patrol rifles assigned to each Conservation Officer for Law Enforcement Patrol purposes.
