## REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Health and Human Services, Bureau of Human Resource Management to make a **retroactive** one-time payment from State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2016 funds to Christine Keane Registered Nurse II, New Hampshire Hospital in the amount of \$2,441.78. This payment is to compensate the employee for wages that were not paid for State Fiscal Year 2015. #### **EXPLANATION**
