

Central to large-scale, meaningful impact of these educational practices is the

The Department has also developed a No Child Left Behind Waiver that defines a "Networked" Strategy to transform our programs for school improvement by building the capacity of educators, school leaders, and students to better address their needs and interests and to shift from policies focused on compliance to communities of support. Central to this model is a platform of deep knowledge, access to educational experts and the ability to collaborate in a virtual network.
