2. Authorize the Department of Justice to amend a sub grant with the Department of Safety (vendor #177878-B001) in the amount of \$54,000, approved by Governor and Council on November 20, 2013, item #28, by extending the end date from September 30, 2014 to September 30, 2015 from the 2012 Statistical Analysis Center Grant program for the purpose of providing hardware, software and IT support for the State Police NIBRS Data Collection Center effective from the date of Governor and Council approval through September 30, 2015. No additional funds are being added. This is 100% Federal Funds.

Funding is available in account #02-20-20-201510-5013-072-500576, Job #20SAC12A, Department of Justice Grants Administration, SAC 2012.

This extension request is being made because the Request for Proposals competitive bid process was delayed.



EXPLANATION

Authorization is being requested to accept supplemental funding under the Bureau of Justice Statistics (BJS) federal fiscal year 2012 State Justice Statistics (SJS) program. 
