Re: Blanket Approval for Contemplated Awards for Amounts less than \$5,000

REQUESTED RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZED, the Commissioner of the New Hampshire Department of Transportation, or designee, to approve the payment of contemplated award submittals in amounts less than five-thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars.

EXPLANATION

The Department of Transportation acquires property and property rights that are needed to clear the right-of-way for the construction of transportation improvement projects. In addition, relocation assistance benefits are provided to those individuals, businesses, or non-profit organizations that are displaced as a result of transportation improvement projects. These acquisitions and benefits are provided in accordance with RSA 230 and RSA 231 and are subsequently submitted to the Governor and Executive Council for final authorization of each payment as listed in the Contemplated Awards complied by the Department. The present approval process causes a delay in payment of between six (6) to eight (8) weeks before the owner or claimant is able to receive their payment.

Many of these payments are either to property owners as compensation for the impact of the project, or, to moving companies, estimators, storage companies, displacees, etc. as reimbursement for relocation assistance benefits for which they are eligible. These companies are often smaller privately owned businesses that may experience financial difficulty due to the delay in payment caused by the current approval process. In addition, owners that choose to perform their move themselves must now wait the six (6) to eight (8) weeks before they can receive reimbursement for their work efforts for relocating their personal property.

As part of Department's Quality Improvement efforts, the Right-of-Way Award process was studied. This review determined that over seventy-five (75%) percent of the contemplated awards submitted to the Governor and Executive Council for approval were in amounts less than five-thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars. It is felt that the present process for approval of the submitted contemplated awards causes undue delay in providing payments and benefits to those affected by the Department's transportation improvement projects. In addition, it requires additional time and work effort by the Department's staff, thereby delaying the acquisition and relocation processes. This in turn can delay the advertising and construction of the project since work cannot occur until the right-of-way is cleared.

To improve efficiency in the processing of these payments and to be more responsive to those claimants awaiting payment, it is proposed that the Department be authorized to approve contemplated awards for amounts less than five-thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars. Reports containing a summary of these nominal contemplated awards would be compiled and submitted quarterly to the Governor and Executive Council for their review. Contemplated awards for amounts greater than this five-thousand (\$5,000.00) limit would still be compiled and submitted to the Governor and Executive Council for approval in a similar manner as that which presently exists.

The Department feels that this requested blanket approval would enable the Department to be more responsive and sensitive to the position and needs of the property owners and displacees affected by proposed transportation improvement projects. The Department will utilize this improved efficiency as it continues to develop and construct the State's Ten Year Transportation Improvement Program.

Authorization is requested for the Department to approve Contemplated Awards for amounts less than five-thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars, as outlined above.
