EXPLANATION



This program has been in effect since 1990.

The above-listed individual is an attorney with over 24 years of experience. As a Senior Assistant County Attorney with the Merrimack County Attorney's Office and more specifically a lead prosecutor, prosecuting individuals charged with Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault, Attorney Rotman will bring the skills and knowledge that are essential to the operation of the victims' compensation program.
