Dear Governor and Councilors:

REQUESTED ACTION

Be it authorized the Adjutant General be designated to apply for, receive and administer federal military aid funds in compliance with applicable State and Federal laws and regulations.

EXPLANATION

The New Hampshire National Guard from time to time is eligible to receive federal monies for the construction and alteration of armories as well as the operation and maintenance of our military facilities within the State.

Pursuant to RSA 110-B:28 I, all armories and other facilities of the New Hampshire National Guard "shall be under the general charge and control of and shall be regulated by the Adjutant General . . .". I need to have the authority on file, approved by the Governor and Council pursuant to RSA 124:4 to apply for, receive and administer federal assistance. Therefore, in accordance with RSA 124:4, I respectfully request that you designate the Adjutant General as the proper person, on behalf of the Adjutant General's Department, to apply for and administer federal funds. An appropriate letter addressed to me and signed by the Governor and Council to be kept in our files would be appreciated.

I am attaching for your approval a suggested letter. Of course, Governor and Council approval will be required for any specific contracts or agreements and this letter is in no way deemed a waiver of the requirements of Governor and Council approval for those contracts.

Dear Brigadier General Mikolaities,

Pursuant to RSA 124:4 you have been designated as the proper person in state Government to, and you are hereby authorized to take all necessary action to apply for, receive and administer any federal benefits, facilities, grants-in-aid, or other federal appropriations or services made available from time to time to assist state activities related to the New Hampshire National Guard or the Adjutant General's Department. In addition to such other instruments, documents and agreements as you may execute under this authority, you also may, whenever the same shall be required as a condition to the receipt of federal assistance, with the approval of the Governor and Council, execute indemnification agreements in the name of the State with and for the benefit of the United State.
