REQUESTED ACTION

- 1. Department of Education in the amount of \$385,466 for the continued support of the Mathematics and Science Partnerships (MSP) program, effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council approval through December 31, 2018. 100% Federal Funds.

EXPLANATION

The NH Department of Education received a Mathematics and Science Partnerships (MSP) grant award from the US Department of Education. Its purpose is to encourage collaboration among institutions of higher education, local school districts, elementary schools and secondary schools in order to develop and offer professional development activities that increase the subject matter knowledge and teaching skills of mathematics and science teachers.

The following appropriation authorities are being requested:

Class 010-Personal Services Perm. – Additional appropriation needed to support an existing position will provide additional assistance to process the MSP funds to LEAs, monitor LEA spending and gather necessary data for proper MSP accountability.

Class 020-Current Expenses - Appropriations reduced due to current expenses projected to be less than current appropriation.

Class 027-Transfers to DOIT - Appropriation reduction due to zero anticipated expenditures for FY 2018.

Class 028-Transfer to General Services - Appropriation reduction due to zero anticipated expenditures for FY 2018.

Class 029-Intra-Agency Transfers - Appropriation reduction due to zero anticipated expenditures for FY 2018.

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Class 030-Equipment New Replacement - Appropriation reduction due to zero anticipated expenditures for FY 2018.

Class 039-Telecommunications- Appropriations reduced due to telecommunication expenses projected to be less than current appropriation.

Class 040-Indirect Costs - Appropriations reduced due to indirect cost expenses projected to be less than current appropriation.

Class 041 – Audit Fund Set Aside – Additional appropriation needed to pay required audit fees.

Class 042-Additional Fringe Benefits—Appropriations reduced due to additional fringe benefit expenses projected to be less than current appropriation.

Class 060-Benefits – Additional appropriation needed to cover the cost of health and dental insurances and FICA for the existing position.

Class 070-In-State Travel – Appropriation reduction due to zero anticipated expenditures for FY 2018.

Class 072 – Grants-Federal – Additional appropriation needed for subgrants to LEAs.

Class 080-Out-of-State Travel – Appropriation reduction due to zero anticipated expenditures for FY 2018.

Class 102-Contracts for Program Services- Appropriations reduced due to contract expenses projected to be less than current appropriation.

2. Nature, Need, and Duration:

The Department is requesting authorization to use a portion of additional grant funds to support an existing position. This existing position will provide leadership and support for the grant. The primary goal of the MSP grant is to encourage collaboration among institutions of higher education, local school districts, elementary schools and secondary schools in order to develop and offer professional development activities that increase the subject matter knowledge and teaching skills of mathematics and science teachers.

3. Relationship to Existing Agency Programs:

The purpose is to provide additional assistance to process the MSP funds to LEAs, monitor LEA spending, and gather necessary data for proper MSP accountability.

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- 4. Has a Similar Program been Requested of the Legislature and Denied?
- 5. Why wasn't this Funding Included in the Agency's Budget Request?

The Department did not include this program in the Agency's Budget Request because the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) eliminated the MSP program. However, the prior grant awards have 27 month performance periods, bringing the availability of funds to December 2018.

- 6. Can any Portion of the Grant Funds Be Utilized?
- No. All funds are necessary to fulfill the intent of the grant that was accepted by the Granting Authority.
- 7. Estimate the Funds Required to Continue the Position: No additional funds will be required.

In the event Federal Funds become no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support this program. Attached are copies of the grant awards.
