- The Respondent is found in default of the <u>Order to Cease and Desist</u> and the Order to <u>Show Cause</u> in the above referenced matter;
- 2) The <u>Order to Cease and Desist</u> is made permanent pursuant to N.H. RSA 421-B:23, and the Respondent shall cease and desist from violations of N.H. RSA 421-B.
- The Respondent's broker-dealer agent license is hereby revoked pursuant to N.H. RSA 421-B:26, III and RSA 421-B:10.
- 4) The Respondent shall pay administrative fines and penalties of \$50,000 to the Bureau pursuant to N.H. RSA 421-B:3, RSA 421-B:3-a, RSA 421-B:10, RSA 421-B:11, and RSA 421-B:26, III.
- 5) The Respondent shall pay investigation costs of \$50,000 to the Bureau pursuant to N.H. RSA 421-B:22.
