## **EXPLANATION**

Agency Income from the Management and Protection Fund is derived from various sources, the majority of which is from the sale of timber on state lands.

We are requesting use of funds to purchase (3) vehicles not previously requested in our 2019 budget. This is under the recommendation of the Department of Administrative Services in response to the failure of automotive dealerships that have been awarded state contracts to fulfill vehicle requisitions in a timely fashion.

In 2018, due to delays beyond our control via the state contract for vehicle purchases, our forest management vehicle order was not fulfilled for two vehicles that were ordered to replace two others which became unserviceable during the year. We anticipate that this year additional vehicles will be rendered no longer serviceable within our aging fleet. The average age of our vehicle replacement is 12 years and in excess of 120,000 miles.

Going forward, with guidance from Administrative Services, we will be managing a vehicle replacement plan that will be based on a lower useful life average. We expect this will provide less maintenance costs and better predictability of anticipated unserviceable vehicles due to age and use. This more sustainable replacement strategy also takes into account growing delays in vehicle delivery dates based on industry conditions that have produced less reliability of meeting delivery date commitments as outlined within the state contracts.

In the interim, to get ahead of this compounding issue of shortfall in fleet needs and protracted delays in delivery of new vehicles, we seek to order additional vehicles immediately to replace aging ones. We have been told to expect a delay in receiving the 2019 vehicles ordered as well.

The following appropriation is requested for Fiscal Year 2019:

Class 030 - Equipment \$82,500, for 3 vehicles
