REQUESTED ACTION


Pursuant to RSA 94:3, the New Hampshire Liquor Commission with the authorization of the Office of the Governor, respectfully requests approval of an annual salary step increase for Joseph W. Mollica, Chairman, (Unclassified Position # 9U137), in the amount of \$5,871.84 from Grade II, Step 6 (\$118,707.68) to Grade II, Step 7, with a new annual salary of \$124,579.52, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval. Funding 100% Liquor Funds.

EXPLANATION

RSA 94:3, "Yearly Service Increases" states, in part, that "upon recommendation of the appointing authority, the holder of any position mentioned in RSA 94:1-a shall be entitled to an annual increase in salary amounting to 1/5 of the difference between the minimum and maximum salary for said position but in no case shall the total salary exceed the maximum as herein established."

Chairman Joseph W. Mollica was appointed to his position on July 1, 2011 and he is eligible to advance to the next step on the salary scale. As the Chairman, he ensures that the overall operations of the NH Liquor Commission are effective and efficient in order to optimize profitability and provide service to the customers of the commission.
