#### **REQUESTED ACTION**

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Nicholas Chong Yen, Position # 9U052, (Appropriation #02-20-20-201010-2620-013-500132) as an Assistant Attorney General, at a salary level of \$64,500, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or March 15, 2019, whichever is the latter. Mr. Chong Yen will be fulfilling a position term which ends on October 31, 2022.

#### **EXPLANATION**

Mr. Chong Yen is a resident of Concord, and a member of the New Hampshire Bar. He received his law degree from the University of New Hampshire School of Law in 2016, and his undergraduate degree from the University of Ottawa, in 2013. He joined the Department of Justice in August, 2018 as an Attorney in the Criminal Justice Bureau where he has prosecuted drug trafficking crimes. Prior to joining the Department, Mr. Chong Yen was an Assistant County Attorney at the Grafton County Attorney's Office from September 2016 to August 2018. In view of Mr. Chong Yen's performance, I am requesting his current salary be increased by \$3,000 from \$61,500 to \$64,500. This pay raise will become effective on March 15, 2019. I plan to assign Mr. Chong Yen to the Election Law Unit.

RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) provides that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.
