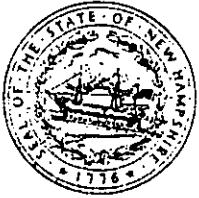

Requested Action

- Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a, VI authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police, to accept and expend \$176,000.00 of federal pass-through funds from the Office of Highway Safety, entitled NH State Police Virtual Private Network (VPN) Installation to provide assistance to local municipalities in designing, configuring, and deploying a VPN solution required to access the J-ONE network. Effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council approval through September 30, 2020. Funding Source: 100% Agency Income.
- Pursuant to RSA 124:15, and contingent upon approval of requested action #1, authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police, to establish class 046 consultant positions for the purpose of providing assistance to departments in designing, configuring, and deploying a VPN solution. Effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council approval through September 30, 2020. Funding Source: 100% Agency Income.

Justice-One Network Environment (J-ONE). The move to VPN will expand the ability of more law enforcement agencies to process electronic citations (E-citations) and access the electronic crash records management system (eCrash). The VPN is the communications backbone of the criminal justice system in the State.

The goal for J-ONE is to increase the speed and accuracy of reporting by capturing the data at the sources, as quickly after the event as possible, and moving it electronically through the system with a minimum of manual re-keying. This will enhance both highway and public safety and be an effective use of resources.

The funds are to be budgeted as follows:

The funds in class 040, Indirect Costs, are not appropriated because the indirect costs are not an eligible expense against contracts over \$25,000.00.

The funds in class 041, Audit Fund Set Aside, are not appropriated because the department that receives the Federal grant from the federal granting agency is responsible for paying the audit fund set aside.


The funds in class 046, Consultants, are needed for to hire the contractor to provide assistance in designing, configuring, and deploying s VPN solution.

The following information is provided in accordance with the Comptroller's instructional memorandum dated September 21, 1981.

- 1) List of personnel involved: *Temporary consultants.*
- 2) Nature, Need, and Duration: *The temporary consultants will provide for the increased need for subject matter experts beyond the limited resources of in-house personnel in the design, configuration, and deployment of the VPN solution.*
- 3) Relationship to existing agency programs: *This expands the capacity to achieve missions within the Division of State Police and other projects directly related to the particular project.*
- 4) Has a similar program been requested of the legislature and denied? *No.*
- 5) Why wasn't funding included in the agency's budget request? *It was unclear at that time that there would be a potential need for a consultant to complete these tasks.*
- 6) Can portions of the grant funds be utilized? *This request is 100% federally funded.*
- 7) Estimate the funds required to continue this position(s): *The temporary consulting positions are estimated at \$176,000.00.*

In the event that Agency Income becomes no longer available, General and/or Highway funds will not be requested to support this program.
