### REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, Division of the Arts, to award a Public Value Partnership Grant in the amount of \$13,000 to NH Film Expo (VC #162697), Portsmouth, NH to strengthen their capacity for affordable diverse arts programs to New Hampshire residents and visitors, effective upon Governor and Council approval through June 30, 2019. 100% Federal Funds

### **EXPLANATION**

Public Value Partnerships are awarded to nonprofit arts organizations, with a minimum of 5 years of continuous arts programming and professional staffing, to strengthen their capacity for offering affordable, diverse arts program to New Hampshire's residents and visitors. Grant categories and deadlines are advertised through the divisions' website, social media and electronic newsletters.

At a recent meeting, the NH State Art Councilors unanimously voted to accept the Arts Division's Public Value Partnership Review Panel's recommendations for the partnerships based on its funding priority ranking within a competitive review. The six-member peer panel, facilitated by an Arts Councilor, considered 17 criteria to arrive at a consensus ranking for each application. Each panelist is advised, both individually and collectively, of their obligation to disclose any conflict of interest and themselves from assessment if a conflict is present. The evaluative criteria range from the administrative capacity of the organization, to artistic quality, strategic planning, community impact and accessibility.

The Attorney General's office has approved the agreement as to form, substance and execution.

# NEW HAMPSHIRE STATE COUNCIL ON THE ARTS GRANT AGREEMENT

In the performance of this grant agreement, the Grantee is in all respects an independent contractor and is neither an agent nor employee of the State.

- The Grantee agrees to abide by the limitations, conditions and procedure outlined herein and in the attached appendices. If appropriated funds for this grants program are reduced or terminated, all payments under this grant may cease. That determination rests within the sole discretion of the Council.
- 3. PAYMENT will be made following the receipt and execution of all required documents and approval of the Governor and Executive Council
- 4. FINAL REPORT: The Grantee agrees to submit a final financial and narrative report on a form provided by the Council no more than 30 days after the end of the grant period. Failure to submit the final report will render the Grantee ineligible for Council funding for two years.
- 5. **SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY**: No provision of this contract is to be deemed a waiver of sovereign immunity by the State of New Hampshire.



Nicole Gregg Co-Founder, Executive Director New Hampshire Film Festival

Over the course of Gregg's leadership of the New Hampshire Film Festival, she has successfully increased and managed a combined fiscal and in-kind budget that started at \$2,000 the first year of the event and has now grown to \$350,000. She was responsible for obtaining the organization's 501(c)(3) status and has ultimately steered NHFF into the premiere film event in the state, as well as a major festival in New England. Gregg also helped secure NHFF a role as a prestigious festival on the international circuit thanks to its selection by MovieMaker Magazine as one of the Top 50 Film Festivals worldwide for the past five years running. She has expanded the festival exponentially, seeing incredible growth in submissions, recruiting and securing local and national sponsors, creating community partnerships, and overall maintaining and increasing the depth and scope of the festival in terms of duration and logistics. She is the brainchild behind New Hampshire Day, which has expanded into one of the signature events of the festival showcasing the best independent filmmakers from across the state. Gregg is also responsible for working with and developing the festival's marketing and public relations plan, selecting the final film program including spotlight screenings, and producing special events in addition to overseeing all facets of the festival from special guests, jury members and panelists, filmmaker relations and all staff positions.

Prior to Gregg's work on NHFF, she graduated from the George Washington University in 1997 and studied art history and photography at Parsons School of Design in Paris during a semester abroad. She then began her career in independent film in the casting department at the critically acclaimed Shooting Gallery film production company in New York City. Her first feature film credit, You Can Count On Me directed by Kenneth Lonergan, went on to receive two Academy Award nominations. Other film credits in casting include Julie Johnson starring Courtney Love and Lili Taylor, and 3AM starring Danny Glover and Michelle Rodriguez. Gregg relocated to Portsmouth in 2001 and began working at the Portsmouth Chamber of Commerce as the Events Manager. Her roles there included securing all sponsorship and coordinating all production of monthly networking events, galas, and major fundraisers and overseeing an annual budget of \$100,000. Her love of independent film and knowledge of events and community lead her to discover her dream job of running an international film festival right in her own backyard of Portsmouth, while also finding time to raise a family.

Gregg served as a Commissioner for the New Hampshire Film and Television Office from 2004-2007 and was named a "Remarkable Woman of the Arts" by New Hampshire Magazine in 2008. She is currently a Corporator at Provident Bancorp, the Mutual Holding Company of The Provident Bank and has served as a panelist and juror at various film events for the Filmmakers Collaborative in Boston.
