REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department (NHFGD) to accept and expend twenty four thousand four hundred and three dollars (\$24,403) in federal funds from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration for the purpose of operating the Greenland Discovery Center campus and supporting winter education programming from date of Governor and Council approval through June 30, 2019. 100% Federal Funds.

EXPLANATION

Thirty eight thousand five hundred and six dollars (\$38,506) have been secured in additional grant funding from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) to the Great Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve. The additional funding from NOAA is intended to assist with yearly operational funding for supplies, contracts, federally required travel, and full time and temporary staff that implement education, research, land management and community outreach programs. This memo requests twenty four thousand four hundred and three dollars be added to FY 19 appropriations, and the remainder will support full time staff and benefit costs that are already in the authorized budget. The additional funds will be spent as follows:

- Class 020: \$6,401.00 dollars to fund basic operational costs associated with keeping three buildings maintained, purchasing supplies for education, research and stewardship activities.
- Class 023: \$1,000.00 to cover raising costs associated with heat, electrical and utilities. Last year's actual costs were very close to 100% of what was budgeted, and we anticipate needing to heat one additional building this winter.
- Class 030: \$1000.00 to purchase a replacement laptop for staff.
- Class 050: \$11,727.00 to support winter hours for two part time temporary positions; a naturalist that will help develop a teacher training program, and a facilities and maintenance laborer.
- Class 060: \$851.00 to support the associated benefits for part time temporary staff increases.
- Class 080: \$2,000.00 to cover travel requirements that are a condition of the grant with NOAA: travel for five people to Duluth, MN for one week and travel for one person to Washington DC for one week. Estimates based on actual costs of hotel, airfare, etc. indicates that the current budget cannot meet the match requirements.
- Class 103: \$2,000.00 to assist with historic inventory and documentation for buildings that are on NHFG owned property.

No additional New Hampshire Fish and Game funds are required, the required match for this award, is already provided in the authorized budget.

General Funds will not be requested to support this project.
