# REQUESTED ACTION

Approve Richard Reader's request to perform the following work on Lake Winnipesaukee, in Alton. File # 2013-00390. This project will not have significant impact on or adversely affect the values of Lake Winnipesaukee.

Construct a 6 ft. x 38 ft. piling supported dock connected to an existing 4 ft. x 38 ft. cantilevered dock attached to an existing 45 ft. long breakwater by a 6 ft. x 12 ft. walkway on an average of 100 ft. of shoreline frontage, on Lake Winnipesaukee, in Alion.

The Department imposed the following conditions as part of this approval:

- 1. All work shall be in accordance with plans by Winnipesaukee Marine Construction revision dated April 04, 2013, as received by the NH Department of Environmental Services (DES) on April 12, 2013.
- 2. This permit shall not be effective until it has been recorded with the Belknap County Registry of Deeds office by the Permittee. A copy of the recorded permit shall be submitted to the DES Wetlands Bureau by certified mail, return receipt requested, prior to construction.
- 3. This permit shall not preclude the Department of Environmental Services (DES) from taking any enforcement or revocation action if the DES later determines that any of the structures depicted as "existing" on the plans submitted by the applicant were not previously permitted or grandfathered.
- 4. Appropriate siltation/erosion/turbidity controls shall be in place prior to construction, maintained during construction, and shall remain in place until the area is stabilized.
- 5. This permit does not allow for future maintenance dredging.
- 6. The dock shall not extend more than 38 ft. lakeward at full lake elevation of 504.32 ft.7. The dock shall not measure more than 6 ft. wide at any location along the length.
- 8. The walkway between the proposed dock and the existing dock shall not be more than 6 ft. wide at any location.
- 9. The minimum clear spacing between piles shall be 12 ft.
- 10. All activities shall be in accordance with the Shoreland Water Quality Protection Act, RSA 483-B. The owner is responsible for obtaining any Shoreland Permit that may be required per RSA 483-B, for construction, excavation or fill that will occur within the Protected Shoreland.

#### **EXPLANATION**

The DES Wetlands Bureau approved this project on June 19, 2013. DES supported its decision with the following findings:

- 1. This project is classified as a major project per Rule Env-Wt 303.02(d), construction of a major docking facility.
- 2. The applicant has an average of 100 ft. of frontage along Lake Winnipesaukee.
- 3. A maximum of 2 slips may be permitted on this frontage per Rule Env-Wt 402.13, Frontage Over 75'.
- 4. The proposed docking facility will provide 2 slips as defined per RSA 482-A:2, VIII and therefore meets Rule Env-Wt 402.13.

Application file documents are being forwarded to the Governor and Executive Council in connection with their consideration of this matter pursuant to RSA 482-A:3,II.(a) as it is a major project in public waters of the state.






Install a 6'x30' crib supported dock, 12' from existing breakwater dock with a 6'x12' connecting walkway.

The NH Natural Heritage database has been checked for records of rare species and exemplary natural communities near the area mapped below. The species considered include those listed as Threatened or Endangered by either the state of New Hampshire or the federal government. We currently have no recorded occurrences for sensitive species near this project area.

A negative result (no record in our database) does not mean that a sensitive species is not present. Our data can only tell you of known occurrences, based on information gathered by qualified biologists and reported to our office. However, many areas have never been surveyed, or have only been surveyed for certain species. An on-site survey would provide better information on what species and communities are indeed present.

This report is valid through 10/10/2013.






