### **REQUESTED ACTION**

- Authorize the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Long Term Supports and Services, Bureau of Special Medical Services to hold a program, "Developmental Screening in New Hampshire: A Stakeholder Meeting" for Department staff, contractors, and stakeholders who work with children and families with and/or at risk for developmental delays, various special health care needs, and/or complex conditions, on May 7, 2019, at the Courtyard Marriott, Grappone Conference Center in Concord, New Hampshire for a total conference cost not to exceed \$5,006.50, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval through June 30, 2019. Funds are available in the accounts below. 36% General Funds and 64% Federal Funds
- Subject to the approval of Requested Action #1, authorize an advance payment of \$400 to the Courtyard by Marriott, Grappone Conference Center, 70 Constitution Ave, Concord, NH, 03301 (vendor code 158921-B001) to secure the date and facility.

#### **EXPLANATION**

The "Developmental Screening in New Hampshire: A Stakeholder Meeting" program will improve knowledge and understanding for developmental screening with Department staff, contractors, and other providers. The focus of the program will be on ways to strengthen the system and improve outcomes for developmental screening in New Hampshire. A direct result of the program is that families with young children will have increased access to, and an improved overall experience with developmental screening, referrals, services, and resources that support growth and optimal development. Participation will enhance staff leadership skills and competencies on the subject. Program attendance will enable staff, contractors, and providers to better help families manage unique challenges involving their child's developmental disability and/or chronic health condition through family directed education and support.

Additionally, the program will bring together diverse partners to strengthen the community infrastructure for families by assuring that the Department, its contractors, and other providers offer services that are based on current best practice and comprehensive information on developmental screening. The program promotes greater system efficiencies by preventing the potential for duplication of support and services. The Department expects 100 individuals from throughout New Hampshire to participate in this stakeholder meeting. The Grappone Conference Center was selected based on its central location, space to accommodate the number of attendees, and availability for the meeting date. Attendees are not required to pay any registration fee nor is it anticipated that there will be any overnight accommodations. See attached conference agenda and listing of stakeholders for additional information. An itemization of the services to be provided with associated costs is attached.

Should the Governor and Executive Council deny this request, Department staff, contractors, and providers who offer developmental screening and related services to young children and their families, will not learn about serving them in a more collaborative and efficient approach potentially resulting in reduced positive outcomes for screening.
