Pursuant to RSA 110-B:75; and in accordance with RSA 4:8, authorize the Adjutant General's Department to accept a building addition to the Administration Building at the New Hampshire State Veterans Cemetery from the New Hampshire Veterans Cemetery Association (NHVCA) valued at \$469,008.04.

EXPLANATION

RSA 110-B:75 states that The Adjutant General may accept, on behalf of the state, conditional and unconditional gifts including grants of money, material, equipment, services, and facilities from any source, public or private, for the operation, maintenance, and improvement of the Cemetery, with the concurrence of the Governor in accordance with the provisions of RSA 4:8.

Dear Chairman Chandler and Honorable Members of the Committee:

Requested Action

Pursuant to the provision of Chapter 137:1, Laws of 2015, Design and Construction of Addition at State Veterans Cemetery; Exemption, the Adjutant General's Department, on behalf of the New Hampshire Veterans Cemetery Association (NHVCA), requests approval from the Capital Budget Overview Committee for NHVCA to design and construct an addition to the Administration Building at the New Hampshire State Veterans Cemetery.

Explanation

The NHVCA proposes to contract for the design and construction of a one-story wood frame addition (32' x 40') of the south end of the Cemetery's Administration Building. The addition will provide a large multi-function room, dividable into two separate rooms, to be used for various educational purposes and meeting room space to include school groups, local civic groups, Veterans groups, etc. In addition, this proposed addition would be utilized to provide refreshments at gatherings such as POW/MIA vigils, wreath laying and pickups, and Memorial Day and Veterans Day ceremonies.

The NHVCA will provide all funds for the design and construction of the addition and it will be donated to the State of New Hampshire, Adjutant General's Department upon project completion. The project will be overseen by the Bureau of Public Works, Design, and Construction. No general funds will be utilized for any part of the design, construction, or oversight of this project.

Please see the attached concept drawings and photographs showing the existing building and the proposed location of the addition (traffic cones show the outside corners of the addition).

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Fifteen

AN ACT relative to a construction project at the state veterans cemetery.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 137:1 Design and Construction of Addition at State Veterans Cemetery; Exemption. The New
2 Hampshire State Veterans Cemetery Association, subject to the approval of the capital budget
3 overview committee established in RSA 17-J, shall have the authority to design and construct an
4 addition to the administration building at the state veterans cemetery.

5 137:2 Project Oversight. The New Hampshire State Veterans Cemetery Association shall utilize
6 a licensed independent architect or professional engineer to oversee the design and construction of
7 this addition. The architect or professional engineer shall be selected by mutual agreement by the
8 department of administrative services, division of public works design and construction, and the New
9 Hampshire State Veterans Cemetery Association. The department of administrative services,
10 division of public works design and construction shall provide oversight of the design and
11 construction of the building addition. The division of public works design and construction shall
12 represent the adjutant general and the state in order to assure compliance of the plans and
13 specifications for the project with accepted state standards for building design and construction. The
14 building shall not be deemed completed until certified by the division of public works design and
15 construction that the addition has been constructed in accordance with the above standards. The
16 New Hampshire State Veterans Cemetery Association shall reimburse the division of public works
17 design and construction for its design and construction oversight services at a cost not to exceed 4
18 percent of the project cost.

19 137:3 Exemptions. For the purposes of the planning and construction of this addition, the New
20 Hampshire State Veterans Cemetery Association and the adjutant general shall be exempt from the
21 requirements of RSA 9, RSA 14:30-a, VI, RSA 17-M, RSA 21-I:78-86, and RSA 110-B.

22 137:4 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
