Requested Action

To authorize New Hampshire Employment Security (NHES) to make retroactive payment in the amount of \$3,412.29 for our employee Geoffrey Martin. The retroactive payroll payment is for the period 1/5/09 through 6/30/12. This payment reflects the difference in hourly rate between an Interviewer Trainee labor grade (14) and an Interviewer I grade (16). This employee was originally hired as an Interviewer Trainee, however a review conducted by the Division of Personnel at the employee's request, has determined he met the minimum qualifications for the higher Labor Grade position in the class, Interviewer I. 100% Federal funds.

Explanation

NHES is requesting approval to pay Geoffrey Martin in the amount of \$ 3,169.80 the difference in hourly rate for the higher labor grade position from the period 1/5/09 through 6/30/12.

When Geoffrey Martin applied for an Interviewer position in our Keene office, he submitted a state application along with a resume and transcripts. These documents were not attached to the application and therefore his Bachelors and Masters degrees were not considered in the certification process. As a result, he was certified at the lower level of Interviewer Trainee.

A review of Geoffrey's previous experience and education confirms that he should have been placed at the higher level Interviewer position, and is deserving of a retroactive increase in his pay.
