REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a,VI, authorize the N.H. EXPLANATION

This request is to accept Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 funds to assist Low Income households with water and wastewater expenses (LIHEAP). New Hampshire is currently a LIHEAP (Low Income Household Energy Assistance Program) grant recipient and, therefore, we are eligible to receive these emergency funds. LIHWAP funds are available to those who qualify for the LIHEAP program.

The Department of Energy will provide these funds to assist low-income households, particularly those with the lowest incomes, that pay a high proportion of household income for drinking water and wastewater services, by providing funds to owners or operators of public water systems or treatment works or to reduce arrearages charged to such households for such services. Energy will be contracting with the five New Hampshire Community Action Agencies currently assisting the approved LIHEAP fuel assistance clientele.

In the event that these Federal Funds become no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support this program.
