## EXPLANATION

This request is retroactive because the Department requested to convert this position to a full-time, permanent position effective July 1, 2019 in the FY 2020-FY 2021 budget process; however, because of the Continuing Resolution, the position was not converted and must be reauthorized under the authority by which it was created.

The Program Specialist Il was created pursuant to RSA 21-I:54 and is assigned to the Bureau of Family Assistance.
