

DEFINITIONS -

Antiered Deer: A deer with at least one antier three (3) inches long.

Antlerless Deer: A deer without antlers or with antlers less than 3 inches long. Any Deer: All deer regardless of sex or age.

* Nonresident youth hunters may participate provided N.H. youth can hunt during youth deer hunts in their state of residence.
