The New Hampshire Department of Justice is seeking approval to accept and expend a grant award from the US Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime specifically geared towards teaching and enhancing proper techniques used by individuals directly servicing victims of crime. These funds were not previously budgeted because the grants were awarded on a competitive basis with no guarantee that New Hampshire would receive an award.

The Department of Justice will utilize a portion of the funding to create and implement a Statewide Victim Assistance Academy to provide ongoing, multidisciplinary trainings to victim service individuals and agencies throughout the state. Additionally, a modest amount of funding will be set aside to provide scholarships for entities to attend national trainings.

Performance will be measured by the number of trainings conducted and by the number of victim service individuals attending the trainings. Any training put on by the Department of Justice will be evaluated by attendees. The evaluations will be utilized to enhance future teaching sessions.

Federal award funds are budgeted to support the activities as follows:
