Requested Action

Pursuant to RSA 4:8, authorize the Department of Safety to accept the donation of two new generators, with a total value of \$2,000.00, from the Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) to be used by the New Hampshire State Police Special Event Response Team (SERT). Effective upon Governor and Council approval.

Explanation

The Department of Safety, Division of State Police, has received a donation of two new generators from the Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) as part of the 1033 Property Program. The 1033 Program provides for the transfer of surplus military equipment from the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) to Law Enforcement. Every state has a 1033 Program which was created to reutilize surplus military equipment that would otherwise be destroyed.

These generators will operate power tools used by Special Event Response Team (SERT) cut team members to combat protestor devices used during demonstrations.


Sir,
