Executive Order 2013-09

An Order Declaring the State of Emergency Over

On July 3, 2013, I declared a state of emergency under the provisions of New Hampshire RSA 4:45, finding that a natural disaster of major proportions had occurred within this state due to a system of severe weather pattern bringing thunderstorms along with torrential and persistent rains, and that the safety and welfare of the inhabitants of this state required the declaration of a state of emergency as defined in RSA 21-P:35, VIII.

The severe weather pattern has subsided and our inhabitants are safe, therefore maintaining the state of emergency is no longer justified. I, therefore, declare the state of emergency over as of noon today, based on the authority vested in me by RSA 4:45, II(b).

I further direct that as soon as possible, this executive order be filed with the Secretary of State and that widespread publicity and notice be given of this executive order.
