EXPLANATION

The Bureau receives unfunded gas tax from fuel use by off-highway recreational vehicles and has consistently spent less from these funds due to the uncertainty of overall OHRV and snowmobile registration totals. The Bureau is requesting to budget and expend gas tax revenues, pursuant to RSA 260:61, I-a, for general operating expenses and administration of the grant-in-aid program.

The following additional appropriation is requested for Fiscal 2019:

Class 020 - Current Expense \$39,000, to pay for project materials on trails;

Class 022 -Rents and Leases OTS, \$29,000, for administrative property leases and construction equipment rental;

Class 023 -Heat Electricity and Water, \$4,000, for utilities for district office locations; and

Class 030 - Equipment \$26,216, to purchase additional trail counters and replace aged snowmobiles.

In the event that excess snowmobile registration fees are no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support this program.
