REQUESTED ACTION

- 1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract amendment, (Contract #4001763), with Worksafe Traffic Control Industries, Inc., (Vendor # 160535), of Barre, VT., by increasing the contract amount by \$190,000.00 from \$1,239,750.00 to \$1,429,750.00 for furnishing, installing, relocating, operating and maintaining an automated, real-time, Smart Work Zone/Intelligent Transportation System package for the Interstate 93 expansion construction projects effective upon G&C approval. 100% Federal Funds.
2. Further, authorize to amend the contract completion date from November 21, 2014 to May 21, 2015, effective upon Governor and Council approval.

EXPLANATION

The Salem-Manchester, BI-A001(196), 13933Z contract was approved by Governor and Council on October 12, 2011 (Item #86) on a basis of a low bid for an original contract encumbrance of \$1,239,750.00. The contract is proposed to be increased by \$190,000.00 to address the following items:

- 1. Unanticipated costs to inspect and upgrade the opticom components for the automated gate operator at the Lowell Road/I-93 emergency access road. The initial installation did not include sufficient grounding to protect the system from lightning strikes. Estimated Cost \$15,000.00.
2. Unanticipated costs to extend the Smart Work Zone/Intelligent Transportation System maintenance contract by six months. The Department has requested this extension to ensure continuity of operation of the system while a new, similar contract is developed, put out to bid, and contract awarded. Estimated Cost \$175,000.00.

Turnpike toll credit is being utilized for match requirements, effectively using 100% Federal Funds.

Your approval of this resolution is respectfully requested.
