Advisory Opinion 2014-2
Response to a Request for an Advisory Opinion
from Senator Jeffrey Woodburn

Senator Jeffrey Woodburn has sought an Advisory Opinion about whether sponsored support for meals and accommodation to be received by Senators during a projected tour of the North Country, will qualify for exemption from the prohibition on "Gifts" under RSA 15-B:3, as "Expense Reimbursement" under RSA 15-B:5.

According to information provided by Sen. Woodburn, in addition to visits to North Country health, educational, industrial and correctional facilities, the projected tour would include free accommodations and a reception provided by the Omni Mount Washington Resort and a dinner sponsored by the New Hampshire Association of Realtors.

Based on the information provided by Senator Woodburn about the tour's purposes and activities, such support would so qualify. See Interpretive Ruling 2013-1.


Senators receiving such support must report it in accordance with RSA 15-B:6.
