

At a meeting of the Proprietors of the Hampton Causewey Turnpike Corporation, holden on the 20th day of Feb. 1826. It was unanimously
voted that this Corporation will relinquish to the towns of Hampton & Hempton
Falls respectively all their right to keep up any gate, and to take toll on
the same with the Canaliand ditches on the sides of said Turnpike, not including
but reserving the buildings and uplands appertaining to the same for the sum
of \$5000.

Voted that the town of Hampton accept the Proposals of the Proprietors of the Hampton Causeway TurnpikeCorporation contained in their vote of Feb. 20, 1826. \$3000.00 of the \$5000.00 paid by Hampton.

In order that said Turnpike road way become a free road, to be supported by the towns of Hampton & Hampton Falls in the same manner as if the said Turnpike road had been originally paid out by said towns as a public highway.




