### REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 4:8 authorize the State of New Hampshire Liquor Commission to accept a donation of 6 Teknion work stations, 20 cabinets, 20 chairs, 20 three-drawer file cabinets, and 9 two-drawer file cabinets donated by Sonus Networks, Inc having an estimated value of \$6,000 upon Governor and Council approval.

### EXPLANATION

The Liquor Commission originally requested the State accept a donation of 12 Teknion work stations from Sonus Networks, Inc. with an estimated value of \$12,000. Governor and Council approved this request at their meeting on January 16, 2013 (Item #1E). When the furniture was recently delivered, it was discovered that Sonus had included six additional workstations, 20 tall cabinets, 20 chairs, 20 three-drawer file cabinets and 9 two-drawer file cabinets.

These additional six workstations, chairs, and cabinets have a value of \$6,000 and will be utilized in the offices at the NHSLC Division of Enforcement.

Sonus Networks has no relationship and does not do any business with the NH State Liquor Commission.
