VI and N.H. RSA 421-B:26, III, as in effect at the time of the violation alleged

in the Bureau's Staff Petition.

4) The Respondent shall pay the outstanding administrative penalty of

\$1,150.00 as required by N.H. RSA 421-B:8 as in effect at the time of the

violation alleged in the Bureau's Staff Petition.
