Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

## REQUESTED ACTION

1. Authorize the Department of Justice to accept and expend a grant from the Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Statistics, to be used to support statistical analysis efforts, in the amount of \$60,069, effective upon Governor and Council approval through September 30, 2014. This is 100% Federal Funds.

Funds are to be budgeted in existing account #02-20-201510-5013, Department of Justice, Grants Administration, Statistical Analysis Center (SAC FFY 12) as follows:

2. Contingent upon approval of Requested Action number one, authorize the Department of Justice to enter into a subgrant in the amount of \$54,000 with the New Hampshire Department of Safety (Vendor #177878-B001), utilizing funds from the United States Department of Justice's Bureau of Justice Statistics FFY 2012 Statistical Analysis Center Grant Program for the purpose of updating and enhancing the current crime statistics repository effective with the date of Governor and Council approval through September 30, 2014. This is 100% Federal Funds.

Funding is available in account #02-20-201510-5013-500576, Job #20SAC12A, Department of Justice, Grants Administration, SAC FFY 12 as follows:

## **EXPLANATION**

Authorization is being requested to accept supplemental funding under the Bureau of Justice Statistics (BJS) federal fiscal year 2012 State Justice Statistics (SJS) program. This is block grant funding that is offered to assist states in compiling, analyzing and disseminating crime statistics. This funding will add to funding already awarded to New Hampshire. These funds are received annually and included in our regular state budget; however, this award exceeds the amount currently budgeted, necessitating the acceptance of these additional funds.

If approved, these funds will allow the Department of Safety to update and enhance the repository that contains National Incident-Based Reporting System data collected from the vast majority of police departments statewide. The repository as it currently operates is lacking the newly added FBI criminal codes such as identity theft, computer hacking, and gender/race bias crimes. It also does not allow collection of certain data such as location of the crime, prohibiting the Department of Safety from mapping crime by region.

The lack of accurate and timely crime data hinders lawmakers and law enforcement personnel in setting effective policies to fight crime. Upon completion of the project, we will have access to up-to-date, accurate crime data by neighborhood, town, county, region and statewide to include border counties in Vermont and Massachusetts.

The Statistical Analysis Center is statutorily mandated by RSA 7:40 and is under the direction and supervision of the Attorney General. It was designed to ensure that current, complete and accurate criminal and juvenile justice statistics are available to public officials, law enforcement personnel and policymakers.

In the event that federal funds become unavailable, general funds will not be requested to support this program.
