WHEREAS, at the hearing on the merits, Respondent represented that the first of three tranches of the payment of monetary sanctions would be coming within three to five business days of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2015, the presiding officer issued his <u>Findings</u>, <u>Ruling</u> and <u>Order</u>, which, in part, ordered that the Respondent shall, subject to petition for review by the Bureau, pay restitution of \$99,997.50; and
