REQUESTED ACTION

The Department of Transportation requests placing this item on the Consent Calendar.

Pursuant to RSA 4:8, authorize the Department of Transportation to accept 28,050 trash bags, with a reported value of \$3,006.96, from New Hampshire the Beautiful Inc. for use in the Sponsor-a-Highway Program.

EXPLANATION

NH RSA Title XX Transportation, Chapter 230 State Highways, Section 230:83 Sponsor-a-Highway Program requires the Commissioner of Transportation to "...establish a sponsor-a-highway program by directly involving citizens, groups, associations, and the business community in the beautification of the state's highways."

New Hampshire the Beautiful, Inc. supports this program by donating blue bags for the Department of Transportation to provide to the volunteer groups that remove trash from almost 1,404 miles of State Roadway. During calendar year 2018, 350 volunteer groups picked up 11,503 bags of trash as part of this program.

The Department appreciates the support of New Hampshire the Beautiful, Inc. and all the volunteer groups that make the Sponsor a Highway program a success and help keep our roadsides clean.

New Hampshire Sponsor-A-Highway Program Administered through New Hampshire Department of Transportation Bureau of Highway Maintenance

2018 Fact Sheet

The New Hampshire Sponsor-A-Highway program, in cooperation with New Hampshire the Beautiful, coordinates volunteers to remove litter from portions of the State's highway system. The New Hampshire legislature established the program through RSA 230:83 and administrative rules were adopted on April 1, 1994. Volunteer groups are asked to sponsor both sides of a 2-mile section of highway and agree to a 2-year commitment. Volunteers are asked to remove litter four times between April and November.

Some highlights for 2018 are listed below:

- 11,503 bags of litter removed (equivalent to approximately 29 tons or 37,960 cubic feet).
- 350 volunteer groups are active with Sponsor-a-Highway.
- 1,404 miles of highway are sponsored.
- New Hampshire the Beautiful donated approximately 14,100 bags to the program.
- Since 2007, New Hampshire the Beautiful has donated approximately 392,250 bags.
- Since 1994, approximately 415,696 bags of litter have been removed from the State's highways with this program (equivalent to 3,185 garbage trucks)
