Explanation

NHES is requesting authority to pay an employee for wages earned not paid from August 19, 2011 through June 30, 2012. This request relates to a reduction-in-force action in 2011, where this employee took an involuntary demotion effecting her earnings. Subsequently, the reduction-in-force action for this employee was reversed based on a further review of the process utilized in 2011. The Department has reinstated Ms. Clark to a position at NHES with the seniority, status and pay equal to that which she had when the Department implemented the 2011 reduction-in-force.

As you know this office represents New Hampshire Employment Security in the above docketed appeal of Michelle Clark before the Personnel Appeals Board (Board). A rescheduled prehearing conference was held on February 6, 2013. At that hearing, and based on our advice, our office provided a letter from you to Ms. Clark and filed the same letter with the Board. This letter was recommended by this office and advised that you were reinstating Ms. Clark to a position at the Department with the seniority, status and pay equal to that which she had when the Department implemented the 2011 mandated reduction in force. It was also our advice that Ms. Clark be paid any salary loss that resulted from her demotion during the period of August 19, 2011 until February 7, 2013.

Based upon the representation made to the Board by this office, Ms. Clark indicated she would withdraw her appeal.
