EXPLANATION

Through previous Governor and Council actions, the Department of Justice has been authorized to award sub grants under the Victims of Crime Act grant program administered through the Office for Victims of Crime. Approval of this request will allow the Department of Justice to make these additional sub grants to the providers listed above so that they may continue their existing programs, which provide direct services to victims of crime and training to direct service providers.

New Hampshire Coalition Against Domestic and Sexual Violence and its fourteen member agencies provide crisis intervention, emergency shelter, victim advocacy, support groups and individual counseling as well as information and referrals to crime victims throughout the state.

The Muskie School, University of Southern Maine, plans and executes the annual Maine-New Hampshire Victim Assistance Academy which provides training to victim advocates new to the field, and the Tri-State Advanced Advocate Training Conference which provides on-going education to experienced advocates.

Court Appointed Special Advocates of NH provide support and advocacy for child victims in the court system.

Victims, Inc. provides support and advocacy throughout the state to families of vehicular homicide victims. The organization also serves victims of violent crimes in Rockingham and Strafford Counties with direct support, information, and referrals.

The New Hampshire Department of Corrections Victim Services Unit provides support and advocacy to victims, including victim notification, which is a fundamental right under the State's Crime Victims' Rights law, RSA 21-M:8-k.

Northern Human Services in Berlin, Conway and in Colebrook provides professional mental health services and case management to victims of crime, as well as outreach and training to service providers in the North Country.

The Granite State Children's Alliance and Child Advocacy Centers throughout the state provide safe, child-friendly, and forensically sound interviews of child abuse victims.


Supervised Visitation Centers provide a safe and neutral location where children transfer from the oversight of one parent to the other, in situations where a history of domestic violence, child abuse, sexual assault, dating violence or stalking makes a direct exchange potentially unsafe. Children also are afforded a safe location for visits with the non-custodial parent, as directed by the court.

In the event that federal funds become no longer available, general funds will not be requested to support this program.
