REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Agriculture, Markets and Food, Division of Plant Industry (DAMF) to accept and expend additional Federal Funds from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) in the amount of \$29,501.00, and further authorize the allocation of these funds in the accounts below for the Invasive Insect Survey program grant, effective upon Governor and Council approval through June 30, 2020. 100% Federal Funds.

EXPLANATION

This request will accept funds from the USDA, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) and will be used to maintain part time staffing to implement the program. APHIS provided grant funding to the New Hampshire Department of Agriculture, Markets and Food (DAMF), Division of Plant Industry to conduct surveys for pests that threaten the state's agriculture and the environment. Surveys are also part of a national early detection network. Invasive insect surveys funded through this federal program include a vegetable crop survey and a forest pest and Asian defoliator survey. The vegetable crop survey is for several insect pests which threaten production of alliums like garlic and onions, cole crops such as

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kale, cabbage, and broccoli, and solanaceous crops like tomatoes, potatoes, and peppers. Two of the pests in the vegetable crop survey have been detected in the greater Colebrook area, and monitoring is warranted to inform vegetable growers in the state of the known distribution of these pests. Other pests in the vegetable crop survey have not yet been detected in the state, but are generalist feeders and would also impact orchard crops, ornamental horticulture, and hardwood trees. The forest pest and Asian defoliator survey focuses on a variety of beetle and moth pests not known to occur in the state, but which would threaten hardwood and softwood forests alike. The Asian defoliator survey portion focuses on several strains of gypsy moth that differ from the European gypsy moth standardly found in the state. These Asian strains feed on a broader range of host trees than European gypsy moth, have physiological differences that potentially allow for faster spread, and are morphologically indistinct from European gypsy moth, such that a survey is necessary for detection. Collected samples are sent to a USDA lab for genetic analysis. Other pests in the survey include exotic wood boring beetles and bark beetles that, if established, could economically impact the state's forest economy and culture.

In the event that these funds become no longer available, general funds will not be requested to support this program.
