## REQUESTED ACTION

Approve Ship Ahoy's request to perform the following work on Lake Winnipesaukee, in Laconia. File # 2014-02892. This project will not have significant impact on or adversely affect the values of Lake Winnipesaukee.

Request to expand docking structures within the 20 ft. setback to the abutter following submittal of the required written abutter permission for impacts.

The Department imposed the following conditions as part of this approval:

- 1. All work shall be in accordance with plans by Diversified Marine Construction revision dated December 27, 2014, as received by the NH Department of Environmental Services (DES) on February 16, 2015.
- 2. This permit shall not be effective until it has been recorded with the Belknap County Registry of Deeds office by the Permittee. A copy of the recorded permit shall be submitted to the DES Wetlands Bureau by certified mail, return receipt requested, prior to construction.
- 3. Repairs to these structures may be conducted, as necessary, throughout the duration of this permit provided that the permittee notifies the Wetlands Bureau and Conservation Commission, in writing, of the proposed start and completion date prior to performing any
- 4. Such repairs shall maintain existing size, location and configuration.
- 5. Appropriate siltation, erosion, and turbidity controls shall be in place prior to construction, maintained during construction, and shall remain in place until the area is stabilized.
- 6. This permit does not allow for maintenance dredging.
- 7. The minimum spacing between piles shall be 12 ft. as measured center pile to center pile.
- 8. All seasonal watercraft lifts, to include the seasonal boatlift within the boathouse, shall be removed from the lake for the non-boating season.
- 9. This permit does not allow for any work to the existing boathouse other than the installation of the seasonal boatlift.
- 10. All activities shall be in accordance with the Shoreland Water Quality Protection Act, RSA 483-B. The owner is responsible for obtaining any Shoreland Permit that may be required per RSA 483-B, for construction, excavation or fill that will occur within the Protected Shoreland.

## **EXPLANATION**

The DES Wetlands Bureau approved this project on April 21, 2015. DES supported its decision with the following findings:

- 1. This project is classified as a major project per Rule Env-Wt 303.02(d), modification of a docking facility providing 5 or more slips.
- 2. The Applicant has an average of 418 ft. of frontage along Lake Winnipesaukee.
- 3. A maximum of 6 slips may be permitted on this frontage per Rule Env-Wt 402.13, Frontage Over 75 ft.
- 4. The existing docking facilities on the frontage provide 14 slips.
- 5. The docking facilities as proposed will continue to provide 14 slips as defined per RSA 482-A:2, VIII.
- 6. The applicant submitted signed notarized permission from the affected abutter for impacts within the abutter's 20 ft. setback.

Application file documents are being forwarded to the Governor and Executive Council in connection with their consideration of this matter pursuant to RSA 482-A:3,II.(a) as it is a major project in public waters of the state.

We respectfully submit this request for your consideration.





Project Description: Reconstruction of a docking facility damaged by ice.


The NH Natural Heritage database has been checked for records of rare species and exemplary natural communities near the area mapped below. The species considered include those listed as Threatened or Endangered by either the state of New Hampshire or the federal government. We currently have no recorded occurrences for sensitive species near this project area.

A negative result (no record in our database) does not mean that a sensitive species is not present. Our data can only tell you of known occurrences, based on information gathered by qualified biologists and reported to our office. However, many areas have never been surveyed, or have only been surveyed for certain species. An on-site survey would provide better information on what species and communities are indeed present.
