#### **EXPLANATION**

The Management and Protection Fund agency income is derived from various sources, the majority of which is from the sale of timber on State lands. When the Fiscal Years 2012/2013 budget was established the vehicle prices were estimated below the current contract pricing, therefore additional funds of \$10,002 are needed to purchase two replacement forest ranger trucks. The survey department needs to replace a GPS unit that is no longer working properly at a price of \$8,000, and replacement forestry field equipment is needed for \$2,000.

The following appropriations are requested for Fiscal Year 2013:

Class 030	Equipment \$20,002, amount needed for unanticipated replacement equipment needs; and
Class 039	Telecommunications \$6,500, amount related to increased monthly "per PC" charges.
