- This will also provide an opportunity to meet with Federal partners.

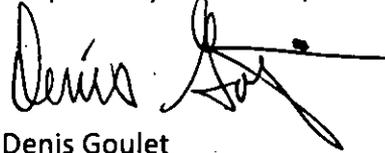
The event begins on September 22nd and ends on September 25th, 2019.

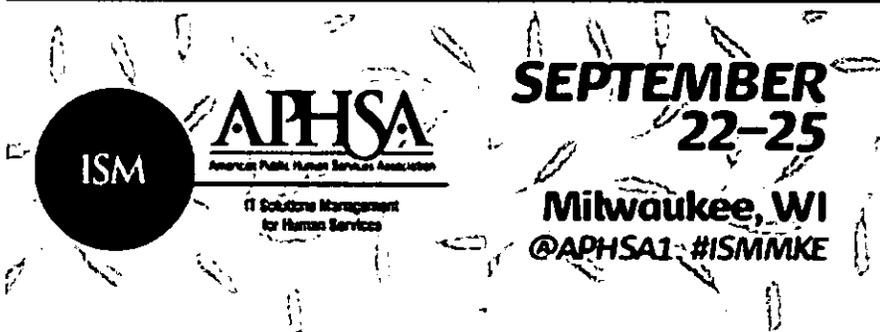
