## EXPLANATION

In Federal Fiscal Year 2015, Congress raised the amount of the Crime Victims Fund to be made available to the States for programs providing direct services to victims of crime. The increase for New Hampshire will allow the Department to allocate almost \$6 million over the course of the four-year grant period. A priority for the allocation of the funds is increased support for the core, stable, and accessible providers that victims in New Hampshire rely upon for safe shelter from domestic violence, advocacy in the courts and through the entire criminal justice process, mental health services, statewide telephone hotlines for 24-hour crisis assistance, and the many other existing services supported with VOCA funding.

The supplemental grant funding listed in paragraph one and paragraph two will allow subgrantees to continue existing programs providing direct services to victims of crime and/or training to direct service providers. The grant supplements will also give immediate relief to programs needing additional funds to meet the needs of victims of crime in New Hampshire. These funds will permit organizations to avoid staff lay-offs, reduce the number of times providers must turn away victims due to insufficient resources, and strengthen outreach efforts so that underserved victim populations can be informed about services available to them.

The new subgrant listed in paragraph three, to the Department of Justice, will enable departmental units that directly service victims of crime the resources to expand services and focus on underserved victims of crime.

In the event that federal funds become no longer available, general funds will not be requested to support this program.





Northern Human Services in Berlin, Conway and in Colebrook provide professional mental health services and case management to victims of crime, as well as outreach and training to service providers in the North Country.


