- How long has this organization been in existence and how long has this agency been a member of this organization? The Office of International Commerce has been a member for one (1) year.
- 2. Is there any other organization which provides the same or similar benefits which your agency belongs to? No, there are no other organizations that OIC belongs to which offers the same or similar benefits on the national trade level. However, under a separate submittal, OIC is requesting approval for membership dues to the Eastern State Council (ETC) which would provide trade support specifically on the regional level. OIC was advised to submit two separate items for these approvals, even though they both fall under the Council of State Governments.
- 3. How many other state's belonging to this organization and is your agency the sole New Hampshire state agency that is a member? Thirty-eight other states (including all New England states) are members of the organization. The Office of International Commerce is the only New Hampshire agency that would be a member.
- 4. How is the dues structure established? (Standard fee for all states, based on population, based on other criteria, etc.) The dues structure is based on a standard fee for all states.
- 5. What benefit does the state receive from participating in this membership? Advocacy: SIDO is the voice of state trade professionals in Washington, D.C advocating greater state-federal collaboration. Training: SIDO organizes formal training seminars for state trade professionals and provides opportunities to attend training programs organized by the US Department of Commerce. Resources: SIDO utilizes surveys and studies to provide trade agencies with up-to-date information on funding opportunities, latest trade trends and best practices.
- 6. Are training or educational/ research materials included in the membership? If so, is the cost included? Explain in detail. Research materials, data and training opportunities are provided through SIDO, and the costs are considered part of the membership dues.
- 7. Is the membership required to receive any federal grants or required in order to receive or participate in licensing or certification exams? Explain. No, the membership is not required to receive any federal grants in order to receive or participate in licensing or certification exams.
- 8. Is there any travel included with this membership fee? Explain in detail any travel to include the number of employees involved, the number of trips, destination if known and purposes of membership supported trips. No travel is included with this membership fee.
- 9. Which state agency employees are directly involved with this organization? (Indicate if they are members, voting members, committee members, and/or officers of the organization.) Tina Kasim, Program Manager for the Office of International Commerce; Nathaniel Nelson, International

10. Explain in detail any negative impact to the State if the Agency did not belong to this organization. SIDO is an organization made up of 38 states and works collaboratively to increase exports, thereby creating and retaining jobs, and enhancing global competitiveness. The convergence of SIDO members' expertise builds critical mass, facilitates innovation, and expands export opportunities.

SIDO enhances state trade programs by advocating on behalf of the states on issues such as trade barriers, sharing trade development data, best practices and advocating for federal international trade programs. Without being a member of SIDO, New Hampshire businesses would not have access to new, additional opportunities to access new markets and international business development, thereby affecting the growth of their businesses.
