Requested Action

Pursuant to RSA 4:8, authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police to accept the donation of a remote operational underwater vehicle, six (6) tool kits, and four (4) portable scales with a total value of approximately \$26,638.00 from the Defense Logistics Agency to be used by the Division of State Police Special Critical Accident Reconstruction Unit (CAR), Troop G (Commercial Enforcement), and Marine Patrol. Effective upon Governor and Council approval.

Explanation

The Department of Safety has been given the opportunity to acquire the above mentioned equipment through the 1033 Program property. The 1033 Program is the transfer of surplus military equipment from the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) to law enforcement. Every state has a 1033 Program which was created to reutilize surplus military equipment that would otherwise be destroyed.

The State Police CAR Unit will use the tool kits to help perform post-crash inspections on vehicles involved in serious and fatal motor vehicle crashes. One tool kit will be assigned to the State Police Aviation Unit for the purpose of performing minor aviation maintenance on the State Police aircraft.

The remote operated underwater vehicle will be assigned to Marine Patrol for searching bodies of water when required. Marine Patrol currently has one operational unit and this additional unit will be assigned geographically to facilitate operations throughout the state.

The four (4) portable scales will be assigned to the weight team at Troop G and will serve as back up scales to the current inventory.


The portable scales will be assigned to the weight team at troop G and will serve as back up scales to the current inventory.
