EXPLANATION

Resume of military service pertaining to Major Gregory D. Heilshorn:

Major Heilshorn has been the state public affairs officer for the New Hampshire National Guard since 2002. His previous assignments include Information Operations Officer, 197th Fires Brigade; Commander, 114th Mobile Public Affairs Detachment; Public Affairs Plans and Targeting Officer, Multi-National Brigade East, Kosovo; and Liaison Officer, US Military Group, US Embassy, El Salvador. In 2010, Major Heilshorn deployed for the second time, serving as the public affairs officer for the 197th Fires Brigade in support of Operation New Dawn. He has also supported public affairs missions in Belize, Germany, and Italy. Major Heilshorn is a graduate of Intermediate Level Education (Command and General Staff College), Combined Arms Exercise Course, Tactical Information Operations Course, Captain's Career Course, Public Affairs Officer Course and Adjutant General Officer Basic Course. In 2009, he attended the Jordanian Army's Senior Leader Cultural Awareness Seminar in Amman. Major Heilshorn was commissioned through the Syracuse University ROTC program in May 1988. He holds a bachelor's degree in journalism from the S.I. Newhouse School of Public Communication. Prior to joining the New Hampshire National Guard full-time, he was a reporter for Fosters Daily Democrat.
