Requested Action

Pursuant to MOP 1102 (L), the Department of Safety, Division of Fire Safety, requests authorization for two Recreational Ride Inspectors to travel over 300 miles one way in a State vehicle issued as a marked Department of Safety vehicle in the amount of \$2,450.08 to attend the 2019 Parks and Carnivals Educational Amusement Ride Safety Seminar in Altoona, Pennsylvania from October 28, 2019 through October 31, 2019. Effective upon Governor and Council approval. Funding source: 100% General Funds.

Funds are anticipated to be available in the SFY2020 operating budget as follows:

Explanation

This item requests authorization for two Tramway and Amusement Ride Inspectors to travel outside a 300 mile radius in a State issued marked vehicle for the purpose of attending the 2019 Parks and Carnivals Educational Amusement Ride Safety Seminar in Altoona, Pennsylvania from October 28, 2019 through October 31, 2019. The round trip mileage from Concord, New Hampshire to Altoona, Pennsylvania is 1,076 miles. The total cost for travel by air and use of a rental car for the five day timeframe in Altoona is \$2,918.00. The cost to travel by state vehicle is \$2,450.08. The savings to travel by state vehicle versus travel by air is \$467.92 (see Attachment A for comparisons). The employees will not be paid overtime during the timeframe of this travel.

The purpose of the seminar is to provide hands-on training and certification testing for the Recreational Ride Inspectors. With the increase in amusement park ride safety concerns, this seminar covers the advancements of amusement rides and devices providing resources to the industry professionals that are dedicated to the safety of the patrons. This seminar includes nationwide attendance that provides collaboration with others in this field to explore new ideas and technology that is available for professionals.

All maintenance on the Department of Safety state vehicle is up to date. If a mechanical issue should occur, notification will be made to the attendees' supervisor and maintenance will be handled through a local contractor in the area.


