EXPLANATION

Resume of military service pertaining to Captain Jeffrey C. Pettee:

Captain Pettee was appointed as a Second Lieutenant on April 2, 2004 upon graduation from Officer Candidate School. His first assignment was as a Fire Direction Officer with Battery A, Second Battalion, 197th Field Artillery. On April 26, 1994, Captain Pettee deployed to Iraq as a Platoon Leader responsible to the troop commander for the discipline combat readiness and training of the platoon. Following his deployment, he became the Platoon Leader for Battery A, Second Battalion. He was given command of Battery B, Second Battalion in December 2006. After successful completion of command, he returned to Battery A, as their Operations Officer. On August 30, 2008, Captain Pettee was deployed to Afghanistan as the Executive Officer for a 16 man Embedded Training Team and Operations Officer for the 207th Corps Afghanistan National Army, responsible to train and mentor the Afghan Army to operate independently. Captain Pettee was awarded a Bronze Star medal for his bravery and courage under intense enemy fire as well as his leadership skills during another mission involving an enemy ambush. Following his second deployment, he returned as the Commander for Headquarters, 3643d Brigade Support Battalion. Captain Pettee was ordered to active duty in October of 2010, as the Rear Detachment Commander, while the Battalion was forward deployed to Kuwait. At the completion of the unit's deployment, he became the Plans Officer for the Battalion. He would also serve as the Operations Officer with the Battalion, prior to his selection for the Individual Training Branch Team Chief for Joint Force Headquarters. He is a graduate of the Combined Arms and Service Staff School and holds a Masters degree from Simmons College.
