EXPLANATION

The Governor's Scholarship Program is designed to provide financial assistance to eligible high school graduates or recent high school graduates to attend a post-secondary educational or training program of their choice within the State of New Hampshire. The program shall provide scholarships which shall apply to the direct costs of the student's education at a participating post-secondary institution.

Each participating post-secondary institution shall receive an allocation based on programs offered. Participating post-secondary institutions may be eligible for multiple allotments if they offer multiple eligible programs.
