Saturday, June 14 –

Monday, June 16th -

- A van will return drivers to New Hampshire.

Friday, June 20 –

- Closing ceremonies will take place from 6 – 9 pm.
- Any van driven back to NH earlier in the week will be driven back to NJ prior to Saturday morning.

Saturday, June 21 –

- Law Enforcement personnel will drive athletes back to NH at 8 am.
